- Action Learning – we use and teach simple action learning techniques to allow participants to fully explore elements of a challenge, generate workable ideas and drive action.

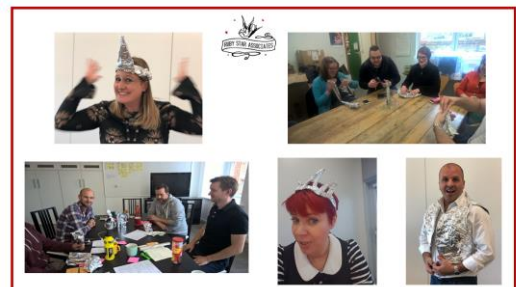
