#### Autumn 2022 Headlines

- The most successful first round in Spacehive history

- Total amount of funding required/target by projects that started a campaign £361,826

## £50k Fund £10k max pledge

- target deprived communities
- address rural poverty and help people to connect with others on the issues affecting them in relation to low income.
- consider the needs of everyone in the community, particularly people from different backgrounds, across different ages and with experience of disability. Examples might include asylum-seekers and refugees, gypsy and traveller communities, women in refuges, people with autism, low income pensioners, carers, care leavers and single parents
- could potentially be replicated across the whole borough or adapted to include rural areas and most isolated groups affected by poverty
- support fair pay and employment practices, including community education around worker led cooperative models
- have a positive impact on environmental and /or mental health and wellbeing,
- pro-actively de-stigmatise poverty
- empower local residents through advocacy and engagement



# Climate Change Fund Cheshire West and Chester Council £10k Fund £10k max pledge

Projects that tackle the climate emergency by delivering quantifiable carbon benefits. Examples include but are not limited to:

- Renewable energy projects
- Energy efficiency projects
- Heat pump projects
- Zero or low carbon transport
- Waste reduction

## **Suicide Prevention**

## £5k max pledge

The objective of this fund is to support the reduction of the number of suicides in middle aged men (target age 40-60) and to enhance men's awareness and ability to improve their own mental health. Projects that pitch to the fund could include:

- Exercise-based activities such as cycling and running.
- Practical activities such as gardening, woodwork and metalwork.
- Arts, crafts and creative activities.
- Bee-keeping.
- Photography.
- Drama and theatre.
